- We are opening on 9<sup>th</sup> June for consultations and examinations. We anticipate that we will begin other treatments in the week of 22<sup>nd</sup> June.
- Because of the epidemic we will, for the foreseeable future, be wearing standard hospital operating PPE of mask, visor, gloves and gown.
- For Covid-19 suppression purposes, it is extremely important that you clean your teeth thoroughly with toothpaste immediately before you come to the practice.
- If you are driving to the practice, please park in our car park and use your car as the waiting room until we call you directly into the surgery.
- If you are walking to the practice, please wait outside on the chairs until we call you inside.
- Hand sanitiser will be provided and should be used at the entrance before and after your appointment.
- Only the patient, and any carer, should come inside.
- Please do not use the toilet and do not put mobile phones or any other hand-held devices down on any surface. Keep them in a pocket or bag.
